POSITION DESCRIPTION

Opportunity

The Board of Directors of the Sawgrass Nature Center & Wildlife Hospital (SNC) is recruiting an Executive Director. This salaried position requires strong leadership and fundraising capabilities in support of SNC's mission, objectives, goals and strategies. Responsibilities include supervision of staff, coordination of fundraising activities, facilities management, programming, member relations, and engagement with a wide range of stakeholders. The position offers modest compensation, allows a flexible schedule and requires some evening and weekend work.

Roles & Responsibilities

Executive Management -- Our Executive Director will play a leading role in planning, coordinating, budgeting and managing all activities at SNC and be responsible for stewardship of SNC resources as well as development of policies and procedures, direction of staff and recruitment of volunteers.

Fundraising and Stakeholder Engagement- Our Executive Director will



Coordinate fundraising activities by working with a special Task Force to grow membership, individual and corporate gifts, government support, and foundation grants. We expect the Executive Director to develop an ongoing relationship with members and donors and represent the SNC in a variety of community settings to strengthen our relationship with key stakeholders.

Programming - Our Executive Director will be called upon to oversee nature programs and continuously improve the quality and variety of our programming/exhibits to ensure that visitors enjoy a meaningful experience aligned with SNC's mission. This aspect of the role also involves planning and overseeing audience development activities, such as marketing, public relations and promotional events.

Facilities Management – Our Executive Director will develop systems and practices to ensure that the facilities and infrastructure of the SNC are maintained in a safe, functional and attractive condition and to help lead conservation efforts for the Center.

Finance - Our Executive Director will participate in budgeting, manage the financial performance of the organization and ensure that its books and records are properly maintained.

Qualifications

The Executive Director must be an experienced leader and creative thinker with a proven ability to work collaboratively .The successful candidate will demonstrate leadership and effective organizational and solid interpersonal skills, including a proven track record for raising funds and building donor relations.
